
Who We Are

Resurrection Catholic Preschool and Kindergarten opened its doors in September 2013. We are located in the Moisant Center for Faith Formation on the campus of Resurrection Catholic Parish. Serving a diverse population of children and families, we promote a partnership among parents, faculty, staff and the community rooted in the Catholic faith. At RCPK, we focus on the development of the whole child with respect and compassion.

Our mission is to be a school of excellence where children are viewed as unique, competent and capable. Guided by an emergent and constructivist curriculum, we work with our students to select topics for investigation and empower children to use their active and creative minds. In supported large and small groups, children learn through hands-on exploration and play.

Teachers encourage the development of each student's moral growth and sense of self-worth by creating a learning environment based on gospel values that supports the dignity of each person. A typical day includes opportunities for individual and group investigation, choice time, music and movement, outdoor play time, and community building. Our mission is to be a school of excellence where children are viewed as unique, competent and capable. Class Offerings and Tuition

Tuition and fees are payable to Resurrection Catholic Preschool & Kindergarten in ten equal payments. A non-refundable \$225 registration fee is required with each child's application. Monthly payments are due by the fifth of each month September through June. An early pay discount of 1% is offered to those who pay for a full year's tuition by September 1. A multiple-child discount of 10% may be applied to the youngest child.
